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# Mock Cable Hat

Ready to try a hat that does not consist mainly of stockinette stitch. The Mock Cable Hat is the perfect hat to try next. The stitch pattern provides you with little cables all throughout the pattern. Enjoy this introduction to cables!

## Materials:

- Loom with 40 (60) pegs in Regular Gauge/sett (1/2" from center of peg to center of peg)
- 1 Skein of Wool Ease Thick & Quick
- Knitting Tool

## Size:

- Child (Adult)

## Skills Set:

- Purl
- Single Stitch
- Flat Stitch
- Gathering Removal

## Pattern notes:

Instructions are provided as follows: Child size (Adult size), when only one set of instructions are provided, follow the instructions for both sizes.

Pattern is worked completely in e-wrap single stitch. Whenever the pattern says to Knit, please use the e-wrap stitch.

## Mock Cable instructions:

The instructions for the mock cable are provided from a knitting view of right to left around the loom (clockwise). Done over 2 pegs. Peg X is on the right, the adjacent peg to the left is Peg Y.

Take the loop of peg X and hold it on a knitting tool or crochet hook. Remove the loop from peg Y and place it on empty peg X. Place the loop being held on the knitting tool on peg Y.



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## Pattern:

Cast on 40 (60), connect to work in the round.

**Set up row:** p to the end of round

**Row 1:** \*K2, P2. Repeat from \* to the end of the round.

**Row 2:** Repeat row 1.

## Setting up for the crossing of loops for the mock cable.

Remove loop from peg 1, hold it with the knitting tool. Remove peg from loop 2, place it on empty peg 1. Place the loop that is being held on the knitting tool on peg 2. Skip peg 3 & 4. Go to peg 5 & 6 and cross the stitches as instructed above. Skip the next 2 pegs. Continue in this pattern all around the loom to the end of the round.

**Row 3:** Repeat Row 1.

Rows 1-3 compose 1 pattern repeat.

**Next:** Work 5 (7) more pattern repeats (Follow Rows 1-3, 5 more times, for a total of 6 pattern repeats)

**Next:** Work 10 rows of single stitch.

**Next:** K2tog all around

**Bind Off:** Remove with the gather removal method. Weave in all yarn tail ends.

**Note:** Pattern can be adapted to any other loom that has a peg number with a multiple of 4.

## Abbreviations

**K:** knit (e-wrap in this hat pattern)

**P:** purl

**K2tog:** knit two stitches together—  
Move the stitches from the odd numbered pegs to the even numbered pegs; then knit the row.
